SUBJECT: NCLB Report Card

1. The School Report Card distributed with your student’s report card in January 2009 included assessment results in the aggregate and disaggregated by race, ethnicity, English proficiency, and economically disadvantaged: by performance level; showing two-year trend data for each subject and grade tested; with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group; and included the percentage of each group of students not tested.

2. The School Report Card distributed with your student’s report card in January 2009 included graduation rates for secondary school students.
3. The AYP status for Forsan ISD is “Meets AYP” which is the highest possible level. The status of each campus in Forsan ISD is as follows: Forsan Jr/Sr High School- “Meets AYP,” Forsan Elementary at Elbow- “Meets AYP”
4. There are no Title I schools in this district identified as in need of improvement.
5. The percentage of teachers in this district teaching with emergency or provisional credentials is 0%, and the percentage of classes in this district that are not taught by highly qualified teachers is 0%. Because this district is a single attendance district, a comparison between high- and low-poverty schools does not apply.
