

Bullying

Forsan ISD takes reported bullying seriously.

Reporting Procedure

1. Any student who believes they have been a victim of bullying may report the alleged act to the school administrator. If a student is more comfortable reporting the alleged act to a person other than the school administrator, the student may contact any school employee or counselor.
2. Any school employee who has witnessed or has reliable information that a student has been subjected to bullying shall report the incident to the school administrator.
3. Upon receipt of a report of bullying, the principal or designee shall investigate, document and remediate the incident.

Each campus handbook has more details related to bullying. The **“Report Incident”** button in the top right corner of the district home page allows for anonymous reporting of bullying and other concerns.

Whether the situations are “bullying” (defined in handbooks) or simply “mean behavior,” FUSD takes reports seriously and continually works to make our schools a comfortable and safe place for our students, staff and community. Parents and community members can help tremendously by demonstrating kindness and caring responses, and by requiring that from their children.
